C. Verifying Taxable Income

You can use either the IRS Data Retrieval Tool through your FAFSA, <u>OR</u> you can submit a <u>SIGNED</u> copy of your complete 2021 federal tax return, including all schedules and attachments. Since the information we are requesting is from 2021, your tax information should be readily available. (If you have not yet filed your 2021 federal tax return, please contact our office.) Below is some helpful information about using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, it is easy to use but if you are not successful with it, please submit your signed copy of your federal tax return as instructed above.

IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT):

Go to studentaid.gov and indicate that you want to make a correction to your FAFSA. Navigate to the "Income" section. If you check that the tax return is already completed, the FAFSA will prompt you about using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. You will not be able to use the DRT if:

- Your tax filing status is Married Filing Separately
- You have divorced after the tax filing year
- You filed a foreign tax return

FAFSA will link you to the IRS web site where you will need the SSN of the first person listed on the tax return. Follow the directions. After the tax information is transferred back to your FAFSA, remember to hit save and submit so our office will receive your new FAFSA. You may do this for student taxes that were filed as well.

Important Note: The instructions below apply to the student and spouse if the student is married. Notify the financial aid office if the student or spouse filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2021 or had a change in marital status after December 31, 2021.
