We define the following for the average student for these courses.

Activity	
Assigned Introductory Readings	20 pages/hour
Assigned Technical Readings	15 pages/hour
Assigned Reflective Readings (E.g. Lectio Divina)	4-5 pages/hour
Assigned Readings with required notes/answers to study questions	4-5 pages/hour
Oral presentation preparation	2 hours for every 10 minutes of presentation length
Service Learning or Civic Engagement	Self-evident
Lab, Studio, or (music) practice time	Self-Evident
Research Papers	2 hours per page
Reflection Papers	1 hour per page
Practicum/clinicals	Self-evident
Study/review for Tests	1 hour for every three in class hours that the test covers. E.g. A test in a three credit hour class that covers 5 weeks worth of material (15 hours of class time) would have 5 hours of study time.
Study/review for Quizzes	1 hour per quiz
